

# Transitional Regulations COVID-19-TCPC

## General

- Frank Schmidt Vice President of the TCPC is the Covid-19 person of TCPC.
- **All the courts are accessible, up to further notices**
- The changing rooms and toilets are closed.
- By reserving a court on the TCPC website, the Adult, Student or Junior member undertakes to apply all the protective measures defined in these Transitional Rules.
- Parents are responsible for ensuring that their children strictly adhere to the guidelines.

## Protection concept

- **The mask wearing is mandatory within the sport centre, for anyone over 12 years old. Please take it off only when you are playing tennis**
- Only two players are allowed on each court. Double matches are prohibited.
- The rules of social distancing rules (10 square metres per person and/or a minimum distance of 2 metres; no physical contact) must be respected at all times.
- Players come to the sports center with their disinfectant (hydro-alcoholic gel) in order to disinfect their hands throughout their period of play.
- Players may only enter in the reserved court if it is free. If it is occupied, newcomers wait outside.
- Players may not enter the court more than 5 minutes before the start of their booked playing period.
- Players enter and leave the outside courts through the respective gates (do not cross a court).
- At the beginning of the period, the players pass the broom on the court, clean the lines and finally disinfect their hands before touching their personal belongings.
- Players bring their own balls and only use them to serve.
- During the playing period, players take care to disinfect their hands regularly.
- Tennis players must have left the court no later than 5 minutes after the end of their reserved playing time.
- At the end of the period of play, players put away their belongings, collect all their waste, leave the court and then the sport centre, taking care not to put their hands on or near their faces.
- Once outside the centre the players disinfect their hands.

## Traceability rules imposed by the OFSP

- To allow a possible chain of infection to be traced, it is imperative that the bookings correspond precisely to the players present on the courts. In the event of a breach of this rule, the reservation rights will be immediately suspended..
- A member of the TCPC who invite a person, is responsible for his or her guest. This means that the inviting member must be able to inform the health authorities of the identity of the guest at any time.
